Packing List

What TO bring:

- Bible
- pen/pencil
- pillow, bed sheets or sleeping bag
- Toiletries
- Towels, swimsuit
- Flashlight
- bug repellent
- set of clothes and shoes/sandals you can get wet/dirty
- fishing equipment if you want to fish in the creek
- offering money and spending money.
- **Speaking of spending money**, the “Wagon Wheel” camp store will be open daily from 8 am to 8 pm. Don’t bring your life savings, but a few dollars for pop, candy, Sky Ranch t-shirts, etc., might be helpful.

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- Water shoes are highly recommended to swim at the riverfront (which includes the water zipline, blob, slide, kayaking, paddleboard etc) at camp. Your water shoes must be able to stay on your feet as you do those activities and walk around the creek. Flip flops are not considered water shoes, water shoes need to have a back on them.

What **NOT** to bring:

- **Electronics** (cell phones, music systems, electronic games, etc.) are NOT permitted at camp. Parents may call or text the director in case of emergencies. When texting, please identify yourself so we can quickly respond to your concern.
 - **Valuables:** Please leave any valuable jewelry or other expensive personal items at home, as we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.
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*If any students bring snacks to share or for themselves, make sure they have a zip-lock bag to store food in. Ants will invade the cabin if open food is not sealed correctly.
