PARTNERSHIP OVERVIEW

FOR THE CITY (FTC) PARTNER ORGANIZATION, AGREES TO:

- 1. Extend Services/Resources to IBC/CC: Provide services/resources to clients, friends, contacts, etc. of IBC/CC in a timely manner when necessary.
- 2. Communicate Monthly Updates: Provide monthly progress updates, prayer requests, and potential transformative opportunities to the FTC Advocate Team in order to ensure the best possible partner relationship.
- 3. Offer Volunteer Opportunities and Necessary Training: Provide the nature, scope, invitation, and definition of volunteer opportunities, overall strategy, and plans to effectively utilize the human, intellectual, financial, and/or physical resources provided. This includes providing necessary training of volunteers in advance and on-site.
- 4. Participate In and/or Provide Promotional Content: Participate in in-person or video correspondence and/or provide additional promotional content that further advances partnership exposure, encourages faithful prayer, and expands serving efforts.

IMMANUEL BAPTIST CHURCH (IBC) AND THE CITY CENTER (CC) AGREES TO:

- 1. Pray: Provide ongoing, strategic, and relevant intercession for both the team (leadership of partner organization) and target (people), and the work. The FTC Advocate Team will continually pray for and make known prayer requests to staff, church leadership, and small groups.

- 4. Go: Enlist and send volunteers to serve with FTC partners as needed. Establish a coalition of likeminded servants consisting of the Strategy Leader and Roundtable that will directly implement the projects and initiatives associated with the partnership.
