RESPONSIBILITY

- Man is responsible to believe and confess (repent and follow).
 - Romans 10:9
 - Acts 16:30-35
 - Luke 9:23-25

FORGIVENESS + SANCTIFICATION

- Following Christ gives the believer total forgiveness of all sin, brings the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, and begins the process of Sanctification.
 - I John 1:9
 - Ephesians 1:13-14
 - Hebrews 10:12-14

CHRISTIAN GROWTH

WATER BAPTISM

- Believer's demonstrate their faith by public baptism (full water immersion).
 - Acts 2:37-38

DISCIPLESHIP

- Believers grow by being taught from the Bible.
 - II Timothy 2:2
 - Matthew 28:19-20

DAILY STUDY + PRACTICE

- Believers grow themselves through daily Bible study and memorization. They also live out the teachings of the Bible.
 - II Timothy 2:15
 - Psalm 119:11
 - Colossians 3:5

DOCTRINE

“Teachings essential to understanding the Bible and living the Christian life.”

HERESY

“A false teaching that is not biblical. It may prevent any possibility for true belief in Christ.”

BASIC DOCTRINE

SCRIPTURE IS INSPIRED

- The Bible is perfectly preserved for us as God intended. We can trust every word in its context.
 - II Timothy 3:16-17

GOD IS FATHER, SON, & HOLY SPIRIT

- God has chosen to reveal His One Self through three identities: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
 - Romans 8:9
 - Matthew 28:19

SCRIPTURE IS ENOUGH

- We need no creed, religion, practice, books, or gods beyond the teaching of Scripture. Acceptance of these things is heresy.
 - Galatians 1:8-9
 - II Timothy 3:16-17
