

# FAQ for the Phase 1 Renovation Plan: The Next Gen Wing

- **What is the purpose of this renovation plan?**
  - As a church we seek to pass on what we have in Jesus to the next generation, that they might know Him as we do and become His disciples. This project will provide a space that is safer, more secure, more welcoming, and more effective for this ministry.
- **Why are we moving forward with this renovation plan during this time when COVID is changing so much in our community?**
  - The Bible tells us that the time we have here on this earth is short. We believe that now, more than ever people need to hear the message of the gospel in all its transforming power. We also believe God calls us to continue to move forward with this mission despite the circumstances in the world around us.
- **How does the creation of a Next Gen wing create a more secure area for our children?**
  - Having all of our children's ministry in one wing, with one entry and exit point, will allow us on Sunday mornings to monitor access to our children much more effectively. The children will have their own set of bathrooms for safety and, should there ever be a security issue in the main church, we will be able to 'lockdown' and secure the wing quickly.
- **Will the Next Gen wing be multipurpose? Will there be any space for adult groups to use?**
  - Although the wing will be designed with children in mind and secured for children on Sunday mornings, there will still be rooms available for adult groups to use during the rest of the week.
- **How much will the project cost? From where will the money come?**
  - The estimated cost of this Phase 1 project is \$120,000. God has blessed our church with many faithful members and attenders who biblically tithe and give to the church. This has allowed us over the last few years to set aside enough cash in savings to fund this project. Please pray for and consider how God is calling you to give to His ministry here and subsequent phases of the renovation plan.

- **Will contractors be doing all the work or will church people be asked to help?**
  - We will be using a contractor for the bulk of the project, however there will be opportunities to help with things like moving items before and after the construction, cleaning, and painting.
  
- **If we are moving the nursery to the Next Gen wing, doesn't that make it less efficient for parents to access the space before and during services?**
  - In the short term, yes it likely will! However, plans are developing for future phases of our renovation that will eliminate this issue and create better traffic flows for the entire building. We are planning for the long term and building in phases in God's timing as He gives us the resources to do so.
  
- **What other phases does the long-term renovation plan include?**
  - We are still reviewing the details of the renovation plan and comparing the costs versus benefits of 2 different options for the long term. The Phase 1 Next Gen wing is the same in both options. Further details for future phases will be communicated soon. We have set goals to improve the flow and function of the facility, develop a more consistent, modern, and welcoming decor, and to use technology in better ways to help reach the community for Christ. More importantly we seek to follow the leading and wisdom of the Holy Spirit as we move forward.
  
- **When will the work be started and completed?**
  - We expect the contractor to start work by the end of this year pending the Elders' final approval of the contract. We hope to have the project completed before spring.
  
- **How can I help and be involved in what God is doing here at Princetown Church?**
  - You can contact the church office if you are available to help with moving items and/or cleaning rooms. We also will need skilled painters at the completion of the project.
  - You can make a gift to the Building Fund of the church to help support future phases of the long-term renovation plan.
