John 8:12

WEEKLY READING

Primary text from this week: John 8:12

Secondary texts from this week: John 8:1-20, Isaiah 42:6-7, Isaiah 49:6, Exodus 13:21-22

GETTING STARTED

Goals for this session: To better understand Jesus' statement "I am the light of the world."

Break the Ice: Do you have any specific memories of a time that you were afraid of the dark as a child?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What do darkness and light commonly symbolize in literature and film? Give examples. Why do you think the Bible uses the concepts of "light" and "dark" to teach spiritual truths?
- 2. What examples in the Old Testament do you recall where light was important? Have the group look up the examples below. How does Jesus' declaration "I am the light of the world" connect to these Old Testament examples?

Light examples in the Old Testament: Genesis 1:3-4, Exodus 13:21-22, Psalm 27:1, Psalm 119:105

- 3. Have someone in the group read **John 1:1-5.** What do you think John means when he says "the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it"?
- 4. Think about your own life before you started following Jesus. In what ways were you "walking in darkness?" How has the light of Jesus illuminated your life?
- 5. Have someone in the group read **1 John 1:5-7**. What do you think John means by the instructions to "walk in the light?" What does it mean to "walk in darkness?"
- 6. If Jesus came to be the light of the world, then why do we still experience so much darkness in the world?
- 7. Have someone in the group read **Matthew 5:14-16.** This week, how can you reflect the light of Christ in your daily life? Be specific.



PRAYER

Pray for each other: Pray that each person in your group would reflect the light of Jesus this week at work, school, home, etc.

Pray for yourself: Pray that the Holy Spirit would help you reflect the light of Jesus this week at work, school, home, etc.

Pray for your four: Identify four people who don't know Jesus (friends, family, neighbors, or co-workers/classmates), and commit to pray for them consistently. Pray that (1) God would reveal Jesus to them, (2) that God would turn their hearts towards Him, (3) that God would put Christians in their path to represent Christ, and (4) that God would give you an opportunity to share what Christ has done in your life.

ACTION STEPS

This week, put a lightbulb somewhere that you will see every day (by your bedside, on the bathroom sink, on your desk or somewhere at work, etc.). Every time you see the lightbulb, remind yourself that Jesus is the light of the world, and that the darkness cannot overcome the light.

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
