WEEKLY READING

Primary text from this week: Galatians 5:22-23

Secondary text from this week: John 13:34, Matthew 5:43-44, 1 John 4:9-11

Break the Ice: Confession time: Did you ever tell a boy or a girl you like them in a note?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What was one thing that resonated with you as you listened to Pastor Doug's message?
- 2. Jesus called His command in **John 13:34** a "new command." What do you think He meant by that? When you read **Galatians 5:14**, how do you think Paul understood Jesus' new command in **John 13:34**?
- 3. Pastor Doug talked about the fact that most of us have been taught by life experience to "love people **the way they love you.**" Have you found that to be true? Explain.
 - Do you think Jesus' command that, "as I have loved you, so you should love others," is a scary command for us to follow? What kind of example did Jesus set for His followers?
- 4. Read **1 Corinthians 13:4-7**. What similarities do you notice between that passage and Paul's *Fruit of the Spirit* in **Galatians 5:22-23**? Why do you think there is overlap between the two?
- 5. Read **Romans 5:8**. What's the difference between God telling us He loves us and God showing us He loves us?
- 6. Pastor Doug said at the end of the message that "**loved people love people.**" Do you agree or disagree with that? Why or why not? How might regularly reflecting on God's love amplify your love for others?



PRAY

Pray for each other: Pray that 1 John 4:9-11 would come alive in each of our hearts this week, and that His love for us would flow out of us towards others.

Pray on your own: Ask God to reveal His love for you in a powerful new way.

ACTION STEPS
