DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What was one thing that resonated with you as you listened to Pastor Doug's message?

- 3. Pastor Doug described Biblical Goodness as **redemptive**. Why is it important to understand that the future destination of the world isn't complete destruction, but complete restoration?
- 4. Pastor Doug described Biblical Goodness as **active**. How does this truth change your understanding of goodness and its potential impact on the world?
- 5. Pastor Doug read **Romans 12:21** in the sermon. As a group, read the complete passage in **Romans 12:14-21**. How do you think these instructions apply to us today?
- 6. Read **Matthew 5:14-16**. What do you think Jesus is referring to when He says, "let your light shine before men..."?
- 7. Read **Ephesians 2:10.** What do you think it means that we were "created in Christ Jesus to do **good works**, which God prepared in advance for us to do"?

Pray on your own: Pray that God would help you embody His goodness this week.
