

# Frequently Asked Questions:

## 1. Is Braeside Open?

- Braeside is open to leaseholders and those renting campsites or cottages. We will NOT be open to the public for recreation.
- We will be manning the front gate on weekends. Weekdays, all visitors must sign-in at the office.
- All leaseholders will receive a blue parking pass that is valid for the season.

## 2. May I have visitors to my cottage/trailer?

- Yes, visitors will be asked to specify where they are going in the park and will need to sign in at the gate or the office.
- We are asking visitors to adhere to a 10pm curfew
- OVERNIGHT visitors need to register at the office and, if applicable, receive a temporary Parking Permit to be displayed for the duration of their visit.
- All guests need be limited to allowable social gathering numbers and adhere to the policies of the Camp, including policies regarding COVID-19.

## 3. What is happening at the pool?

- The Braeside pool is open to Leaseholders and Renters and their families.
- Pool times will be on the app or at the pool
- The wading pool will not be open this summer because of the restrictions in place due to COVID-19.
- Guests of Leaseholders or Renters may purchase a day pass at the office or pool for \$2.50 per day for ages 6 and up.
- The number of swimmers allowed into the pool area has been reduced by the health dept.
- Everyone entering the pool area will be subject to a health screening.
- Leaseholders & Renters will need to show their pool pass to enter the pool
- The pool registration system will not be available during the week. The pool will be first come, first serve.
- **You will be able to reserve a swim time on weekends.** (Friday at 8pm for Saturdays & Saturday at 8pm for Sunday swim times.)

## PLEASE NOTE – When registering for a pool time:

- One Registration per family **BY AN ADULT** is required. DO NOT register for children not in your care.
- Please only register for ONE pool time a day. You are still able to swim at different times; you might just need to wait in line. If you register for multiple swim times per day, only the earliest time you requested will be honored.
- Registrations will only be held for 15min after the start time begins.
- Forms for the next day will be available between 8pm – 9pm, or until time slots are full. (a notification will be sent from the app when the form is open)

## 4. I am a leaseholder; will I need a pool pass for every member of my family? What about my adult children/grandchildren?

- Each leaseholder will get one pool pass. It is for your use, and the use of your immediate family members. (including adult children & grandchildren)

## 5. What activities are happening?

- The Tuck Shop is open daily and serving made to order breakfast on Saturdays. Check the app for times and specials.
- Campfires are allowed, but limited to allowable social gathering numbers
- Using the park equipment is available - however if used, it is at the discretion and responsibility of the parent/guardian. Park equipment is NOT cleaned daily.
- Day Camp for ages 5-12 is happening July 20-24 & July 27-31

## 6. Are the Public Washrooms & Laundry Open?

- Public washrooms and laundry are open.
- Rules are posted in the laundry room and washrooms. (Please be respectful of our cleaning staff and help keep the washrooms & laundry in good condition.)
