

## FAQ

**How will we make sure people are not sitting too close to one another?** We will utilize the CDC recommendation of 6ft per person/family separation guideline. Every two pews have been blocked off for use. Family units, defined as people residing in the same home, can sit together.

**What if more people show up than we can accommodate in the sanctuary?**

We do not expect to reach a maximum capacity of 100 people in the initial opening and reevaluate the need for a second service if we do.

**Where do I enter?**

We will limit access into the building to the front glass (4) doors. In addition, Main external doors and internal doors will be propped open to ensure “touchless” entry. Exit will take place on center and side doors.

**Should I wear a mask?**

Yes, “***You are required to wear a mask before entering and keep masks on until you are outside and further than 6ft from anyone else.***” We will keep our masks on during the service to insure protection to those around us. We have a limited number of masks to make available should someone in attendance forget theirs.

**Will the bathrooms be open?**

Yes, but will be limited to assure physical distancing.

**How will the offering be received?**

Offering can be dropped off in person in the two boxes next to the main sanctuary entrance. You can continue to give online or send offering via US Postal service.

**What about Communion?**

When we have communion, we will provide prepackaged elements available for you to pick up as you enter the sanctuary.

**Where should I park?**

There are no restrictions on where people can park. Our lot is large and spacious, however please be mindful of social distancing while exiting cars to enter the building.

**What happens at the conclusion of the service?**

We know that you may want to stay and visit, however, you are requested to maintain social distancing while moving to your cars using any exit from the sanctuary.
