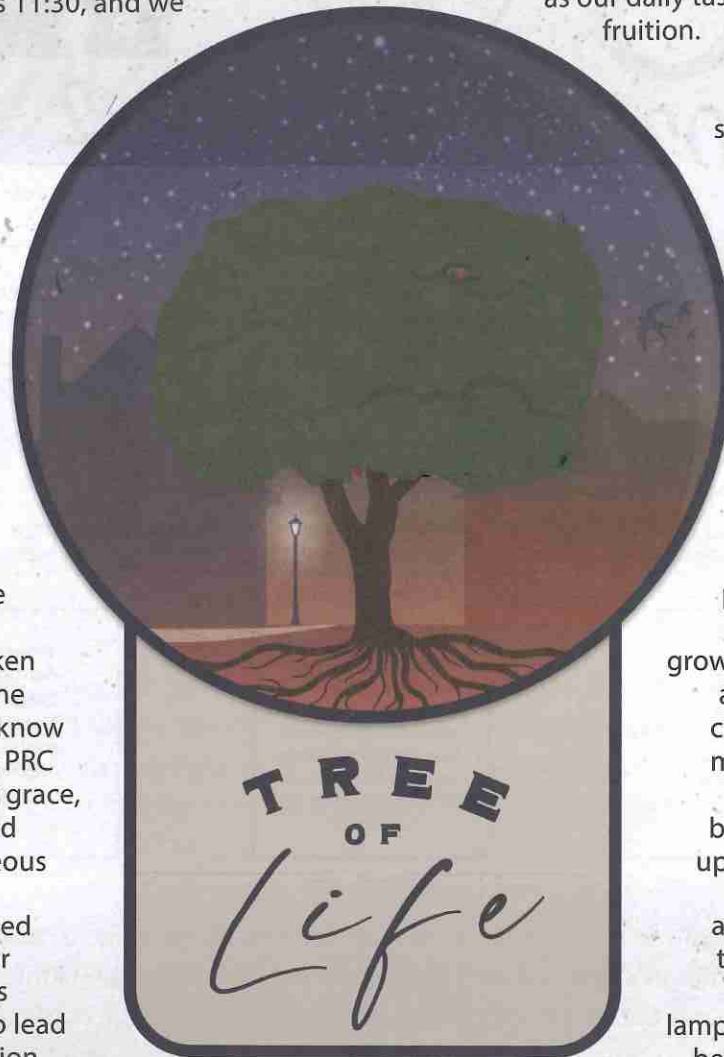

As I studied the verse, allowing it to cling to my heart, I kept envisioning the maple tree that now sits in between our two buildings, uniting both properties. 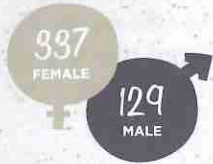

2020 INCOME

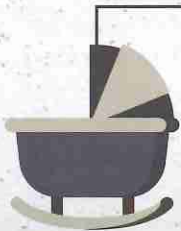

Unfortunately, my husband's American visa was not approved, which began our challenge. However, God placed in my path the right people to help us.

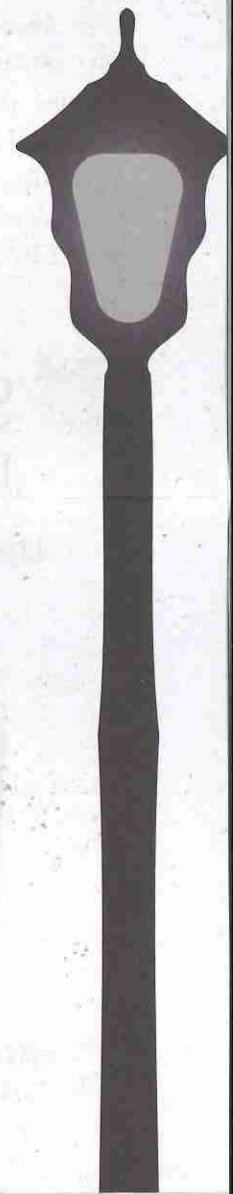

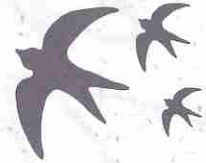
