We will then receive communion together by consuming these wafers and wine this Sunday at the 9 am worship service online.

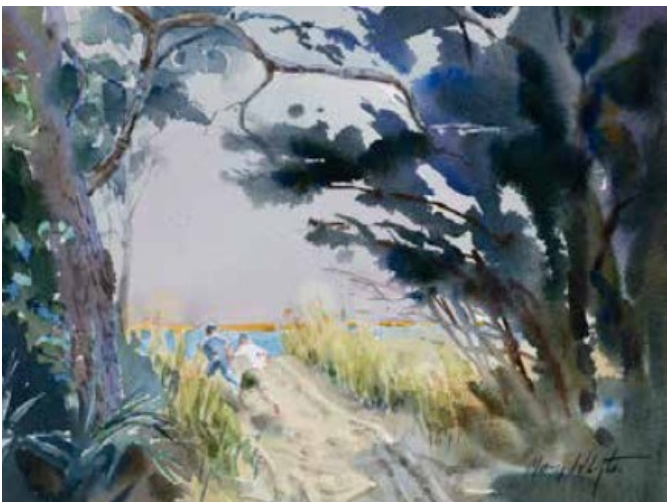
