Dear Volunteers:

Thank you for volunteering to help with our **14<sup>th</sup> Annual Feeding of the Multitude**, which will take place on **Saturday, Nov. 20, 12-3 PM at Walton Hall behind St. John's Parish Church, 3673 Maybank Hwy, Johns Island SC 29455.**

**If you are working on Thursday from 3:45 to 7:45 PM**, you can park anywhere by Walton Hall. **If you are working on Friday from 10 -1:30 PM**, please park in the side lot by Walton Hall. The freezer truck will be arriving some time that day, so we need the front lot clear of cars. **Please report to Sherrie McAvoy in Walton Hall**, and she will give you directions. We have built in 30 minutes after the bag drop off times to allow for additional sorting of the bags.

**Parking and Traffic: We ask all Saturday volunteers park in the church lot and walk up the walk to the volunteer registration desk** near the church playground. There will be **no parking on Walton Hall grounds** in order to keep space for traffic flow on the property. We have room for about 100 cars to line up for the bag pick-up. This will get some of the cars off of the roads before and during the event. When you come to work the event, if you see that traffic is backed up at the Main/Maybank/Bohicket Rd intersection, try to get around it and use the Brownswood Rd. access near the church. If you are coming from Bohicket Rd, use the Angel Oak Rd to get to the church.

**Volunteer Registration Desk: Sat. Nov. 20:** Please check in at the desk and get a name tag. **Also, please do not bring extra volunteers with you.** Come only if you have signed up with your Church Coordinator and you know you are filling a volunteer slot. We know that a wonderful part of the Feeding is the fellowship that we feel with people in our community, and we look forward to having that again. However, because of COVID, we can't accommodate a lot of extra folks, and there will not be work for them to do. We would hate to have to turn people away.

**After signing up at the Volunteer desk, Saturday Greeters & Volunteers working with bags report to Sherrie McAvoy in Walton Hall at 10:30 for orientation.** If you are assigned to a **prayer team, please report to Claudia Boyce, and please be at Walton Hall 15 minutes before your time slot.** If you are assigned to **traffic, please report to Ron Boyce who will be in the main driveway near the Walton Hall entrance.**

For those volunteering until the end of the food distribution on Saturday the 20th, please join us at 3:00 at the main entrance to Walton Hall to sing **Amazing Grace** - a most beautiful **Feeding of the Multitude** tradition!

Please pray that we have a great turn-out, that hearts are opened and that we are instruments for our Almighty God to grow His Kingdom.
