

Requirements to be considered for a volunteer position with Children or Youth

Requirements-

All volunteers (*18 years & older*) that have direct contact with children or youth are required to complete the following:

- Volunteer Application & Covenant - Form
- Child Protection Plan Policy and Procedure Agreement (CPP) – Volunteer Class
- Volunteer Training & Code of Conduct – Volunteer Class
- Child Abuse Awareness Training – On-line (contact Children’s Director to receive link)
- PA State Police Request for Criminal Record Check – On-line
- PA Child Abuse History Clearance Checks – On-line
- FBI Fingerprint Check (or affidavit) – On-line (or form)

Action-

Complete the requirements:

- Volunteer Application & Covenant – Print, complete, return to Children’s Director or Pastor at church

Volunteers who have not lived in Pennsylvania continuously for the past 10 years are required to obtain this clearance

Volunteers who have lived in PA 10 years are required to complete the affidavit and return to the Children’s Director or Pastor at church
