

Frequently Asked Questions

- WHAT RECOMMENDATIONS ARE YOU FOLLOWING? We are following the
 recommendations set forth by the CDC, OSHA, and the County of Sacramento. We
 are going with the state recommendations for maximum number of people allowed
 based on facility capacity, social distancing, traffic control, and sanitization of
 facilities.
- 2. **ARE MASKS REQUIRED?** Masks are not required but are recommended by the County of Sacramento. While we are not mandating the wearing of masks, if you feel more comfortable wearing one, please do. If you forget your mask you can stop by the Information Desk for one.
- 3. WHAT PRECAUTIONS ARE YOU TAKING FOR SANITIZING THE FACILITIES? Our entire facility is cleaned and disinfected both before and after we meet: bathrooms, door handles, pew backs and arms, and all other high-touch surfaces will be cleaned with a disinfectant sanitizing product. We have hand sanitizers placed at most entrances/exits, plus bathrooms are available for handwashing.
- 4. WHAT OTHER THINGS ARE YOU DOING TO STOP THE SPREAD OF THE VIRUS?

We will:

- temporarily remove Bibles, hymnals, pens, and connect cards from the backs of pews.
- temporarily discontinue offering donut holes and coffee.
- discourage shaking hands/hugging and encourage non-contact greetings instead.
- encourage those with symptoms of COVID-19 or who have come in contact with someone who is sick to stay home and engage in the service online.
- postpone the start of life stage groups, Sunday school, and mid-week programs.
- temporarily discontinue distributing bulletins.
- ask that parents print children's bulletins at home and bring them to church.
- not pass an offering basket; use the black lock boxes located in each building.
