Wellness Policy and Procedures

Individual Wellness

- If your child or anyone in your home has had a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever over 100.4 or chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell in the last 48 hours, please stay home.
- At first sign of any of the above symptoms, the sick individual will be sent home.
- All volunteers will be asked to wear a mask. Each volunteer's temperature will be taken with a touchless thermometer upon arrival; screening questions will also be asked.
- Students in 1st – 5th grade are strongly encouraged to wear a mask when not able to social distance outdoors. Face coverings are required when indoors.
- Notify us if/when any member of your immediate family has been diagnosed or directly exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Educate and equip children and family on the importance of social distancing behavior.

Check-In/Out:

Drop off

- We will do our best to remain socially distanced during the drop off/pick up process.
- All check-in will occur in the courtyard.
- Your child's temperature will be taken with a touchless thermometer and screening questions asked prior to admittance to children's area.
- To help with social distancing, we ask only one parent to drop off and pick up.
- Playhouse Nursery and potty-training parents, please place necessary items in a zip top plastic bag labeled with your child's name. We will not be able to accept any diaper or cloth bags.
- Playhouse Playmates pacifiers MUST be securely attached to the child with a clip.
- JumpStreet students should not bring any personal belongings to class except their bible.

Pick up

- Parents are encouraged to exit the area once they have picked up their children.
- We ask that the same parent drop off and pick up the child.

During Class Time

- The number of children in each area will be limited.
- Social distancing will be done to the best of our ability with the understanding that volunteers cannot physically restrict children.
- Activities will be designed to be single use; sharing of supplies will be minimized.
- Snacks will be individually packaged, and volunteers will wear gloves when distributing.
- A limited touch policy will be encouraged. Instead of high-fives, fist-bumps, and hugs, we will encourage elbow-bumps and air hugs.
- All toys, books, and other items will be limited in each class space.
