5. Many of us are good at talking about anything but Jesus with people who don't know him. Knowing that the enemy wants us to keep quiet, how do we overcome this fear to open our mouths for the Gospel?
6. What does your life preach? If someone else had to answer that question, what would they say? Do you preach the risen Christ, or do you preach "other"? Do you preach Jesus, or do you preach "love"? Do you preach the Risen Christ, or do you preach prophecy?
