2. There are times in our daily lives where we will hear the Spirit of God prompting us to talk to, pray for, encourage, or share the Gospel with strangers. How does Philip's strong obedience (v29-30) encourage you to be obedient when the Spirit prompts you?
3. Jesus references "The Kingdom of God" over 100 times in the New Testament. Why is it important to know that the Kingdom of God is present when you are sharing the Gospel with others?
4. Why is it easy to talk to people about aspects of the Gospel such as forgiveness, heaven, joy, and challenging to talk about repentance, obedience, and the death of self? What should our ultimate motivation be in sharing the Gospel?
5. The key components of the Gospel are

 2. Christ
 3. Death
 4. Resurrection
 5. Follow
 6. Repent
