



Spirit Filled Boldness - Acts 2:14-41

1. How does Peter's sermon encourage you to be more bold in your witness for Jesus?
2. Would you say that your belief in the Gospel is more faith-based or fact-based? How does Peter's appeal to facts, history, and evidence bolster your faith in the Gospel?
3. How does knowing that the Gospel message is for all people encourage you to share your faith? How does it encourage you with people who you have written off as "a lost cause"?
4. In Acts 2:37, It says, "Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?" When faced with the truth of the Gospel, it should cause us all to say this same thing. What shall we do? Reflect on this question and ask yourself if you ask of the Lord often, "what shall I do?"
5. Dr. Henry Cloud speaks of people in 3 categories, evil, the wise, and the foolish. Which one are you? Do you ever find yourself altering the light that God is shining on an area of your life to expose it?
6. For many, the struggle with the call to be a disciple isn't the benefits but obedience. Many love the thought of heaven and forgiveness but actively rebel against obedience. What are some of the implications of being a disciple that you struggle in? How are you actively overcoming those hindrances by His Spirit? In what areas of your obedience to Christ are your needing prayer? Take some time to pray for one another and ask God for His power in your life!
