2. God's long-suffering is on display every time he has to repeat something to us. What is something that God has repeated through his word or through prayer that you have a hard time implementing in your life?
3. What command(s) have you implemented in your life? What has been the result of your obedience?
4. As we looked deeper last week, waiting can be challenging. This week we saw in John 16:7 Jesus say it is to our advantage that he leaves and we have to wait for the HS. What is something you are waiting on God's perfect timing for? Have you ever rushed his timing? In what?
5. When it comes to the Holy Spirit, many have become skeptical of the work of the Spirit because they have seen it abused. In what ways have you seen the power of the Holy Spirit abused? What is the balanced approach we are to take that Luke talks about in Acts 1:1-3?
6. How does knowing that we can have the same Holy Spirit that filled Jesus cause you to look at trials, tribulations, and sin differently?
7. One of the great works of the Holy Spirit is his ability to empower us to do what he created us to do as His disciples. What do you want the Holy Spirit to empower you to do for His Kingdom? End your time together praying for his power in your lives to do His will.
