

God Provides Dot Art

Materials

- ☐ One set of the two pictures for each student (following page)
- ☐ Construction paper
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Crayons
- ☐ Glue sticks
- ☐ White and blue paints
- ☐ Cotton swabs
- ☐ Optional: white and blue dot stickers

Instructions

Print and cut out one set of pictures for each student (or let students cut them out). Have students color the pictures then glue them onto a piece of construction paper, leaving room between them.

Next, have students dip the tip of a cotton swab into the white paint and make dots on the paper around the woman with the basket for manna. Then dip a new cotton swab in blue paint and add dots to the rock for water. Allow to dry.

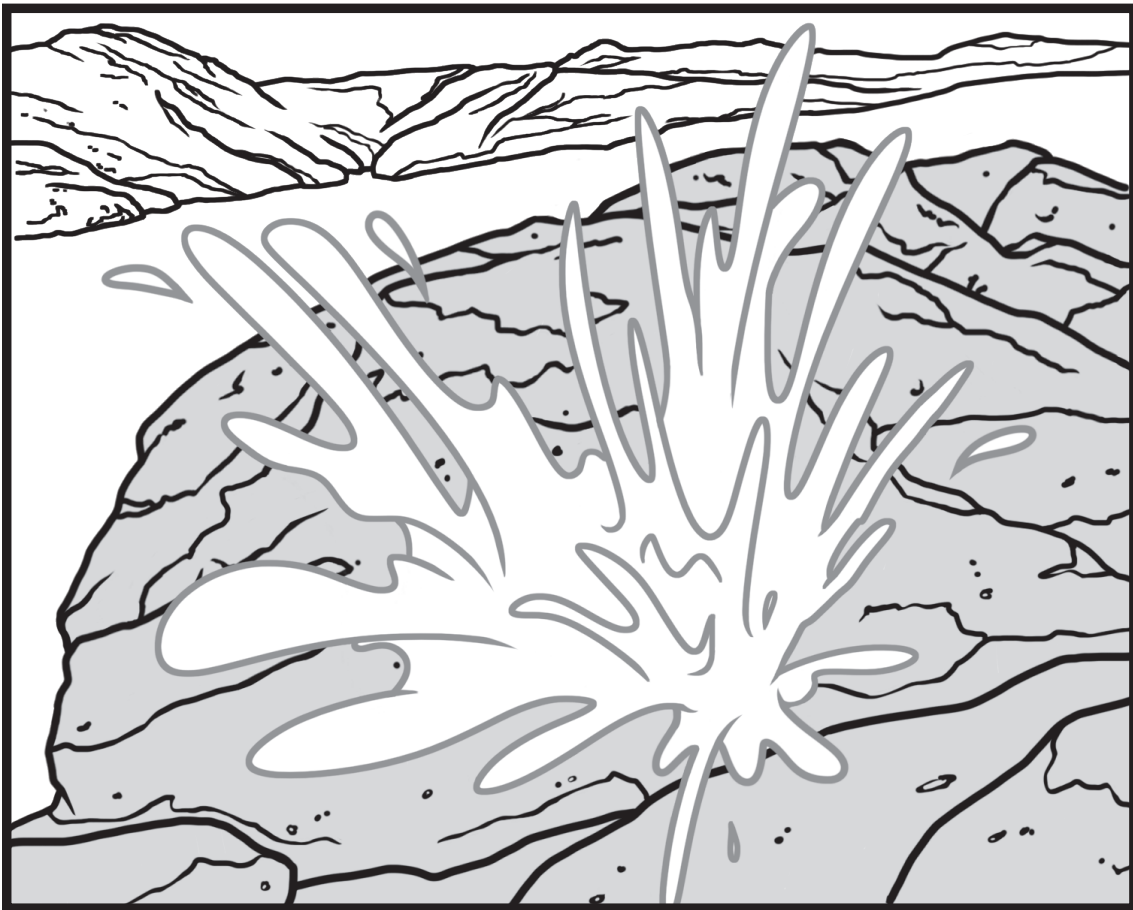
Optional: give students white and blue dot stickers to apply around the pictures instead of using paint.



Suggested Discussion

God gave the Israelites all they needed. He provided special bread in the mornings for them to collect and eat that day. But if they disobeyed and collected more than they needed, trying to save some for the next day, it would get worms and stink! Yuck! God wanted them to obey and trust him each day to provide food.

God also knew they needed water. And he showed them that they didn't need to worry because God could get water out of rock if he wanted to!
