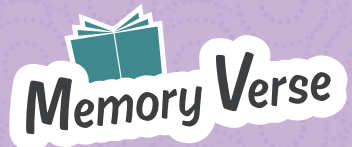

- Twelve men spied out the Promised Land, but only Joshua and Caleb trusted God to keep his promise to protect them and give them the land.

## **OutWord** *For Family Discussion*

Suppose you are talking about the Bible with some friends and they say, “We just don’t believe that part about giants in the land. There’s no such thing as giants!” **What would you say to them?**

*Actually, there are very tall people today that we might call giants. Look at basketball players—some of them look like giants to us. Some are over 7 feet tall! We also know that Goliath was a “giant.” The Bible tells us that he stood over 9 feet high (1 Samuel 17:4). That’s tall! I believe that Joshua, Caleb, and the spies did see giants in the Promised Land, just as the Bible tells us.*
