## **Review Questions**

- 1. What kind of heart did Pharaoh have toward God? A hard heart.
- 2. What was going to happen in the tenth plague? Death of the Egyptians' firstborn.
- 3. How did God tell the Israelites to protect themselves from the tenth plague? Sacrifice a lamb and spread its blood on the doorposts.
- 4. What kind of lamb did they have to use? One-year-old male without blemish (perfect).
- 5. What would God do when he saw the lamb's blood on the doorposts? Pass over that house.
- 6. What is the word for the top of a doorway? Lintel.
- 7. During the tenth plague, the Israelites were instructed to stay in their homes and eat a special meal called what? *Passover.*
- **8.** What did they eat for this meal? Roasted lamb, bitter herbs, unleavened bread.
- 9. What did the bitter herbs remind the people of? Their bitter, harsh life as slaves.
- 10. What does leaven do to bread? Makes it rise.
- **11. What would unleavened bread remind the Israelites of?** *Leaving Egypt in a hurry with no time to let the dough rise.*
- **12.** Name one of the ways God told the Israelites to eat the Passover. Belt fastened, sandals on, staff in hand, in haste.
- 13. What time of day did God strike the Egyptians with the tenth plague: morning, twilight, or midnight? *Midnight*.
- **14.** What did Pharaoh do after he lost his firstborn son? He called Aaron and Moses and told them to leave with all the Israelites.
- **15. Why is Jesus called the Lamb of God?** He is the perfect sacrifice whose blood takes away our sins and protects us from God's judgment just like the lambs in Exodus had to die to protect the people from the tenth plague.
- 16. Who is the only perfect one who can take away our sin? Jesus Christ.
- 17. Can you name one of the three promises God gives in the memory verse? They all start with "I will." I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- **18. Who would like to try saying the memory verse?** Allow several students to try reciting the verse.
