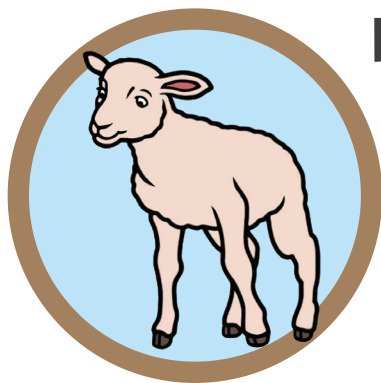

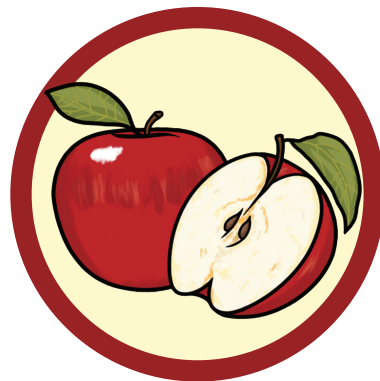

What You Heard *In the Word*

- God gave instructions for a special meal called the Passover. During the tenth plague, God would pass over the houses with lamb's blood on the doorposts.
- Jesus is the perfect lamb of God who saves us from our sins.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did God tell the Israelites to do with the lamb's blood? *Spread it on the doorposts (and lintel) of their homes.*
2. What happened to the Egyptians during the tenth plague? *Their firstborn sons and animals died.*
3. What did God do when he saw houses with lamb's blood on the doorposts? *He passed over those houses and spared their firstborn.*
4. After his firstborn son died, what did Pharaoh tell Moses to do? *Go. Get out of Egypt with the Israelites.*
