What You Heard *In the Word*

- God created the Passover to protect the Israelites from the tenth plague and to remind them of how he saved them from slavery in Egypt.
- Jesus, the Lamb of God, was the perfect sacrifice who died to save us from eternal death. His blood takes away the sin of those who repent and trust in him.

OutWord *For Family Discussion*

Suppose your friend asked you why Jesus is called the Lamb of God. **What would you say?**

That's a great question! John the Baptist called Jesus the Lamb of God in the New Testament, but the meaning of this name goes back to the book of Exodus in the Old Testament. You see, the Israelites, God's people, were slaves in Egypt. God was about to send a terrible plague that would finally cause Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. To protect his people, God instructed them to sacrifice perfect lambs and spread their blood on the doorposts of their houses. When God came to punish the Egyptians, he would see the blood and pass over the Israelites' houses. Just as God provided a way to save his people from this plague, he also provided a way to save us from sin by sending Jesus to die in our place and take the punishment we deserve. Jesus' blood was not put on a doorway but shed on the cross. He willingly sacrificed himself so we can be saved if we repent of our sins and trust in him.
