1. Who did God promise to save from slavery hundreds of years before it happened? *Abram's descendants, the Israelites.*
2. How did God keep his promise to give the people “great possessions” when they left Egypt? *The Israelites asked the Egyptians for jewelry and clothes, and God caused the Egyptians to give it to them.*
3. What does it mean when we say that God is faithful? *He will always keep his promises.*
4. What was it called when the Israelites left Egypt all together? *The Exodus.*
5. What did God use to lead the Israelites on their journey? *A pillar of cloud and fire.*
6. How did Pharaoh feel after they left? *He was sorry he let them go. He changed his mind.*
7. What did Pharaoh and the Egyptians decide to do? *Chase after the Israelites and bring them back.*
8. How many chariots did Pharaoh have: 200, 400, or 600? *600 or more.*
9. Where did the Israelites get trapped? *At the Red Sea.*
10. What miracle did God perform to make a way for the Israelites to escape? *He parted the Red Sea so they could cross.*
11. What was it like when they crossed through the sea? *Wall of water on each side; dry ground.*
12. What did God do to stop Pharaoh's chariots? *He made their chariot wheels clog up so they wouldn't work right.*
13. Why did Pharaoh's army want to turn back? *They realized that God was fighting against them.*
14. What happened when Pharaoh and his army followed the Israelites into the sea? *God caused the sea to rush back into place, drowning the Egyptians.*
15. What did the Israelites do after they saw how the Lord defeated the powerful Egyptian army for them? *They sang and praised God.*
16. According to our memory verse, what will God use to uphold us? *His righteous right hand.*
17. Who can say the memory verse? *Allow several students to try reciting the verse.*
