## God Leads Craft

## **Materials**

- ☐ Cloud and fire pillars (following page) printed on card stock
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Cotton balls
- ☐ Orange and yellow tissue paper
- ☐ Craft sticks

## **Instructions**

Print and cut out one cloud and one fire pillar picture on card stock for each student, or have older students cut them out. Have students color a light blue daytime sky around the cloud pillar and a dark blue nighttime sky around the fire pillar.



Have students pull apart the cotton balls and glue them to the cloud around the text then glue pieces of torn tissue paper to the fire around the text. Glue a craft stick on the back of each picture, or glue the pillars back-to-back with one craft stick in between.

## **Suggested Discussion**

Let's read what your cloud and fire pillars say: "God leads his people by day" and "God leads his people by night." God didn't take the Israelites out of Egypt and just tell them to go on their way. Very few of them had ever been out of the land of Egypt before. They would get lost and hurt out in the wilderness by themselves. God knew they would need him to lead them.

**?** What about us? Does God still lead us today? How does he do that? *Allow discussion*.

Yes, God leads us through his Word, the Bible, and through his Holy Spirit. We don't have a cloud or a huge fire to follow like the Israelites did. But when we study God's Word and pray for God's guidance, he does lead us every day and every night.
