Materials

- ☐ Follow Directions worksheets (next page)
- ☐ Crayons

Instructions

Print one Follow Directions worksheet for each student. Explain that in order to do this worksheet the right way, the students must wait and listen for directions and then do what you say. Pass out crayons. Use the directions below to guide students to complete the worksheet. Check to see how many followed directions correctly.

Directions

1. Find a red crayon and draw a circle around Moses, the man with the staff.
2. Find a blue crayon and draw a square around the tent.
3. Find a yellow crayon and draw a triangle around the cross.
4. Find a black crayon and draw an X over the angry face.
5. Find a green crayon and draw a circle around the rock with water coming out of it.

Suggested Discussion
