

# Authority Game

## Materials

None

## Instructions

*Play this game like "Follow the Leader." Begin by saying, "Since I'm the leader, I have authority to lead you. So, follow me and do what I do." Lead the students around the room (or outdoors) doing different actions as you go for a few minutes then stop. Choose a student to be the new leader. Say, "\_\_\_\_\_, I give you authority to lead the game until I say stop." Continue choosing new students to have authority and lead until each student has had a turn.*

## Suggested Discussion

**?** How many of you liked to be the leader in authority? *Show of hands.*

Many people like to be leaders. That's what we saw in our lesson today. Korah and others wanted to be leaders, too. They didn't want to do the jobs God had given them. But when they became jealous of the real leaders and rebelled, that was sinful disobedience, and God had to punish them.

God gives all of us authorities that we should obey. And when we respect and obey them, we are also being obedient to God.
