What You Heard *In the Word*

- Moses sent 12 spies to explore the Promised Land. Ten of them were afraid and told the people they could not take the land because they did not trust God.
- Two of the spies, Joshua and Caleb, trusted that God would give them victory.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. When the Israelites were afraid, they did not trust in God to help them. What did they let take over instead? *Fear.*
2. What did the spies bring back to show the people? *Fruit.*
3. How did God punish the people for not going into the Promised Land? *They had to wander in the wilderness for 40 years.*
