To literally, ceremonially, spiritually purge, to clean or make whole. To remove by destroying the intermingling of what ever negatively effects something's purity or wholeness.

One day, Jesus went to the temple, the very center of Jewish worship and he CLEANSED it by driving out the distracting hurtful ways men were operating. As he cleansed, he said "My house will be a house of prayer for the nations". This moment is significant for your life today.

Scripture says, "your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit". (1 Corinthians 6:19). It also says, "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you." (I Corinthians 3:16). Another verse says, "you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house."

"Cleanse" represents a focused faith that is free from anything that causes regrets or hinders God's best for your heart and life influence.

As you enter 2022, what does "Cleanse" mean for you? What will be your approach to building your focus? We hope this 21 Days of Prayer will help you experience a greater faith and power of Jesus' work in all of your heart and life.

WHY JOURNAL?

We believe it is MORE beneficial to actually write out your prayers in addition to your worship, praise and personal cries of prayer to God. You need to go back through this as the year unfolds and note your personal development and deepen your reflection, meditation and personal prayers.

HOW TO S.O.A.P.

You'll need three items, a Bible, Pen, & Journal to S.O.A.P. each day.

Which verse stood out to you?

S — SCRIPTURE

Open your Bible to your reading for the day. Take time reading and allow God to speak to you. When you are done, look for a verse that particularly spoke to you that day, and write it in your journal.

What is God saying to you?

O — OBSERVATION

What do you feel God is saying to you in this scripture? Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and reveal Jesus to you.

How can you apply it today?

A — APPLICATION

Personalize what you have read, by asking yourself how it applies to your life right now. Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, a new promise, or corrections for a particular area of your life. Write how this scripture can apply to you today.

Ask God to help you use what you've learned.

P — PRAYER

This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this scripture, or even a prayer for a greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Remember, prayer is a two-way conversation, so be sure to listen to what God has to say! Now, write it out.

KNOWING GOD - YOU ARE CLEANSED BY FAITH

The Most Important Purpose For Anchor Church Is:
HELPING PEOPLE TO KNOW GOD.

Get this: Faith is in your heart - and it is made evident through your mouth. Knowing God requires your mouth coming into agreement with God's Word by faith!.

Read II Corinthians 4:12-20 - Notice: "The same Spirit of Faith".

QUESTION: Do you know that YOU HAVE the same Spirit of Faith OR Spirit-given faith that Moses, Abraham, David and all of the prophets had? Do you want to receive the same measure of faith they received? Do you want God to save you and give you a great measure of faith? Today? He can and He will!

Knowing God Requires Faith.

It is by Grace - through **faith** that you are saved. Ephesians 2:10
It is by faith that we live eternal life now. - II Corinthians 5:7
Faith is the only thing in life that counts. Galatians 5:6
Faith is what we live by. Galatians 2:20
Righteousness is by faith. Romans 1:17, 3:22
You are justified by faith. Romans 3:28
Jesus cleanses your heart by faith. Acts 15:9

There is nothing more powerful for you to shift your entire life-focus toward than your personal faith.

Trust this: A Focused Faith will not only lead you to being saved and whole in life, it will absolutely empower your decisions and lead to fewer regrets.

OVERVIEW: PURPOSE IS DISCOVERED IN FAITH-INCREASING COMMUNITY

The second most important part about Anchor Church is the beauty of helping people DISCOVER THEIR PURPOSE. As you'll see in this week's prayer focus - Faith Reveals Purpose.

HOW TO DISCOVER PURPOSE: The greatest way to Discover Your Purpose in life is to focus your life efforts toward GROWING to use your life more and more in serving Jesus in community with other believers.

You were saved for purpose. You were gifted by the Spirit for purpose. God speaks to you for purpose. God leads you into community with others for purpose.

You are better together with others growing into the purposes of God.

As you pray this week - pay attention to the voice of the Lord regarding:

1. **Your community** - who knows you? Who is helping you personally? Who are you helping?
2. **Your TEAM:** Who are you serving with? Where are you using your gifts IN THE BODY of Christ? How is the body being built up by your life?
3. **Your Best** - if you brought your best this week, what would you bring? What is your best focus? What is distracting you? What is hindering your progress in growing and serving?
4. **Your Joy** - Is anything robbing or distracting your JOY-CHOICE? Joy is a choice that springs from your faith. Is your faith producing joy in your growth and in your service to Jesus?
