He hates you! He wants to destroy you! So it is vital that we <u>prepare</u> for his attacks and <u>practice</u> spiritual disciplines in order to defend ourselves.

We are in a spiritual battle!

How do I prepare for battle?

Read Ephesians 6:10-13

1. Be Strong (vs. 10)

- What does it mean to be strong?
- What does this statement mean..."when we are weak, He is strong"?
- Does God want us operating on our own strength?



- How can I be strong?
 - 1. Admit I am weak.
 - 2. Confess He is strong.
 - 3. Ask Him for strength.

Read Philippians 4:13

What does this say about strength?

Read Ephesians 6:13

2. Stand!

- · What does it mean to stand?
- How can we stand against Satan?
- Read Ephesians 6:12 again. Who are we to stand against? Do we spend a lot of time wrestling with people, what they say or what they do? Why?

Again, read Ephesians 6:13

3. Armor Up!

- Read verses 13-18.
 Identify the pieces of armor.
- Now, let's start from the head & move to our toes.



Philippians 4:13



Helmet of Salvation (verse 17)

- What does it protect?
- How does Satan attack the head region?
- What defense does Salvation bring to our lives?



Breastplate of Righteousness (verse 14)

- What does a breastplate protect?
- How is the breastplate likened to sanctification?
- Is there more protection that comes with sanctification? (Infilling of God's Spirit)?



Belt of Truth (verse 14)

Why is truth important in combating Satan?



What's our best defense against lies?

NOTE: Satan and the World would have us believe there is no absolute truth! "What's true to you may not be true to me!" But there is absolute truth...God's Word!

- Why do we need God's truth when combating Satan?
- How will God's truth become a part of us?

Shield of Faith (verse 16)

- What does it say faith will extinguish?
- Who is firing the arrows?
- How many arrows can faith extinguish?
- What can weaken our faith?
- How is your faith today?
- Take time to pray for one another to have strong faith!



- Ever been hit by any of these arrows?
- >>> Confusion
- >>> Complacency "comfortable where I am"
- Charges (blame game) We blame God and others for where we are in life.
- Contumely (insults)

Sword of the Spirit (verse 17)

- What does the sword represent?
- How important is God's word to you? Why?
- Is your sword sharp or dull? How do you sharpen it?



Feet of Readiness (verse 15)

- What are we to be ready to do?
- Ever missed an opportunity to share Jesus?



Knife of Prayer (verse 18)

- Why would I call prayer a knife?
- Is prayer offensive or defensive?
- Can we pray without ceasing?
 What does that look like?
