ICE BREAKER:

- Share a time when you were chosen first for something.
- Share a time when you were chosen last.
- How did it make you feel?

READ GENESIS 12:1-4

⇒ God chose Abraham!

NOTE: Shortly after Noah and the flood, God chose Abraham as the foundation of humanity.

How would you feel if God chose you?

READ VERSE 4

- ⇒ Abraham listened & obeyed!
 He packed up and followed God.
- If God came to you and told you to leave everything you know and go " to a land I will show you", would you do it?
- Would you be willing to go places you have never been or seen, not knowing where He is taking you?

Share with the group a time you stepped out in faith.

READ GENESIS 15:1-6

• What did God promise to bless them with? Why?

READ GENESIS 21:1-7

NOTE: When Isaac was born, Sarah is 90 years old and Abraham is 100 years old.

Why do you think God blessed them with a son?

NOTE: God is a Promise Keeper!

What promises has God made to you?
 What promises have you made to God?

NOTE: The story of Abraham is one of Abraham listening and obeying and then being blessed.

- Share a time when you listened and obeyed God and God blessed you.
- How do you know when it is God who is speaking to you and not just a voice in your head?

Read Genesis 22:1-18

VERSE 1-

- How was Abraham tested?
- Is this the same thing as being tempted?
- Does God tempt?
- Read James 1:2-4.
- Why does God allow testings?

Verse 1 -

- How does Abraham answer God?
- What does this say about Abraham?

VFRSF 2-

What was God asking? How could He do this?

NOTE: Abraham listened.

VERSES 3-5 -

What was Abraham's response to the request in verse 2?

NOTE: Abraham obeyed!

Read verses 9-12

 What do you need to lay down and allow God to burn up so you can be all He wants you to be?

READ VERSES 13-18

NOTE: Abraham listened and obeyed. God blessed and provided.

APPLICATION .

- Are you listening to God?Are you making time to listen?
- Are you obeying God?
- How is God asking you to obey?

Genesis 12:1-4 New International Version (NIV)

12 The LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

² "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.

³ I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."
