VABLE OR BALO

I had to laugh as I sat on the porch watching our team play a game with the KIDS CONNECTION kiddos on this June morning.

CONNECTION is a summer event for incoming K through 5th graders at our facility. The total number of kids attending was right at 100 with the group split in half and rotating between inside and outside.

called **BELIEVABLE** This game was BALONEY? and consisted of a series of random and goofy statements (see below). After the statement was read, the kids were told to move to one side or the other depending on if they thought the statement was **BELIEVABLE OR BALONEY?**

The group was being watched by a volunteer & staff "army" armed with fully loaded water guns. After each statement, the kids on the side that was NOT correct were then "punished" by those volunteers & staff with fully loaded water guns, which were then reloaded between each statement. If you look closely, you can see the water guns in action in the picture above.

It was cute to see the kids processing how they should respond to the statements, genuinely wondering about the truth of the statements while also appreciating the pleasant and desirable "punishment" (it was 97 degrees at the time) if they got it wrong.

Several of the Believable or Baloney questions:

- Cows can sleep standing up. 1.
 - Believable
- 2. Calico cats are mostly male.
 - Balonev
- Caterpillars have 3 eyes.
 - Baloney, it is actually 12
- Apple sauce was the first food eaten by 4. astronauts in space.

Believable

While the BELIEVABLE OR BALONEY game and its consequences was cute and fun to watch, the larger context was much more significant. 100 little ones, from all over the city, on a hot summer morning, learning about Jesus and having a blast doing it.



Though it is true that they might not remember all the games they played, or the snacks they ate, or the Bible lessons they were taught, as they grow older the deeper realities of consistent exposure to the truth of the Gospel is being firmly embedded in their hearts. Truth be told, it is the mixture of BELIEVABLE and **BALONEY** that does the trick.

Sometimes it might literally be bologna, if that's what we have to feed them that day. Often it's just the baloney of goofiness and fun that is like a magnet to kids of all ages. But always, always, ALWAYS it is the reality of the Gospel, completely **BELIEVABLE** as revealed in the powerful Word of God.

Thank you so much for your faithful partnership with us. It really is precious to us to have so many good friends who share our vision of Taking JESUS to Neighborhood Children, Youth and Families!
