Looking back, it deeply touches me that God led her to do the ministry He had called her to so close to calling her home.

Everywhere Delia went, whether she was at work at the hospital, at church, at a local women's ministry or at House of Faith events, she was always boldly praying and speaking with such confidence about the life changing power of Jesus. Our relationship with Delia began when she would come to House Faith with her children years ago. She allowed her sons to come, but she came with them with a watchful eye. They would pray for their mom and ask her to come with them, and Delia finally decided to go. She began growing in



the Lord and through many ups and downs, she completely surrendered and turned her life over to the Lord. From this point forward Delia loved seeking the Lord through His Word and was committed to serving the Lord and to prayer. One of her favorite verses was **Isaiah 40:7-8** —"The grass withers and the flowers fall, because the breath of the LORD blows on them. Surely the people are grass. At her funeral, many spoke about how committed she was to her family and to her sons, Jerry, Abell, Vince, Kris and Aaron, and their families. Her son, Abell, said of his mom, "My mom was a strong warrior for the Lord."
