Hello, dear friends of House of Faith!

We have kicked off our semester with our students, and I wanted to give you a little glimpse into our days with them. Each Wednesday and Thursday you can find Backyard Bible Clubs meeting around the city. We are so grateful to be back in our pre-pandemic locations! We have 8 clubs that meet on Wednesday and 7 clubs that meet on Thursday. Our children come running out of their schools each week, ready and excited to be at House of Faith, eat some snacks, hang out with friends and learn about Jesus. Our first unit is 7 weeks long and we are learning to “**Be Like Jesus.**”
