



Revenue and Support


Individual Support comes in the form of Electronic Giving (Sharefaith and ACH withdrawals from banks). It also comes by mailin and offering plate checks and cash.

WORSHIP

In this third quarter, both our 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM in-person worship continue, along with excellent live-streamed worship at 11:00 AM that can be accessed on Facebook and YouTube. We have also launched a new worship experience Thursdays at 6:30 PM called *Open Vespers* geared toward those seeking Jesus who have not connected through traditional worship. This year, to date, we have welcomed eight new members into the Goodrich family, seven at our physical location and one from our online campus! We also celebrated one new person's baptism into God's family! We are continually energized by the evidence of the Holy Spirit's good work among and through us.

SPIRITUAL FORMATION

In addition to worship, we believe that to grow as disciples we must be engaged in both personal spiritual disciplines and sharing our faith with others in small group settings. Goodrich UMC has resumed in-person Sunday School and small groups for all ages, and in this quarter, we were so excited to continue our long tradition of sharing Jesus with children through in-person Vacation Bible School! Our youth meet weekly and have been actively involved in connecting on a District level through CCYM. For the musically gifted among us, the choir has also returned to group practice and is leading special music for worship twice a month. Our in-person prayer team, and our online prayer chain continue to surround and uphold the community with prayer.

MISSION & SERVICE

Goodrich has a strong tradition of mission and service, supporting many ongoing groups and projects. We continue to support the ongoing work of the OU Food Pantry which provides assistance to food-insecure students, faculty, and staff associated with the campus. Our youth have taken on the mission of addressing this problem as well with a one-day mission project to assist at Billy Hooten OIMC's food pantry.
