How To Use This Grading Key:

1. This key gives the answers for all *Truth For The World* courses. See the table of contents to find the beginning of each lesson's answers.
2. At the beginning of every lesson, the point value for each answer blank, true/false question or multiple choice question, is given in parentheses after the lesson number. Points will vary by course.
3. After marking the incorrect answers, subtract the total points missed from 100 and give a grade for each lesson in the booklet.

- Example #1:

If you are grading Course 2, Lesson 1, each answer is worth 8 points. If the student answers 1 *Fill in the blank* and 1 *True or False* question incorrectly, figure:

2 answers x 8 points each = 16 points wrong.

To calculate their grade for that lesson:

100 points – 16 points wrong = 84 points.

The student's grade for that lesson would be 84%.

- Example #2:

If you are grading Course 4, Lesson 3 and the student missed 3 of the 5 parts on question #2, plus 2 of the blanks on question #6, then the student had 5 answers wrong. Figure:

5 answers x 5 points each = 25 points wrong.

To calculate their grade for that lesson:

100 total points – 25 points wrong = 75 points.

The student's grade for that lesson would be 75%

4. When a student misses a question, please give them the

correct answer and/or an explanation with the Scriptures they can read. Giving them an appropriate gospel tract which deals with the subject is also helpful.

5. An overall average grade of 75% or higher for all lessons in the course is considered satisfactory. You should issue the student a certificate of completion and send them the next course in the series. If they make less than 75% overall, please ask them to study the material again and take another test.
6. To compute the average grade for the course, simply add the grades for each lesson, then divide by the total number of lessons in that test.

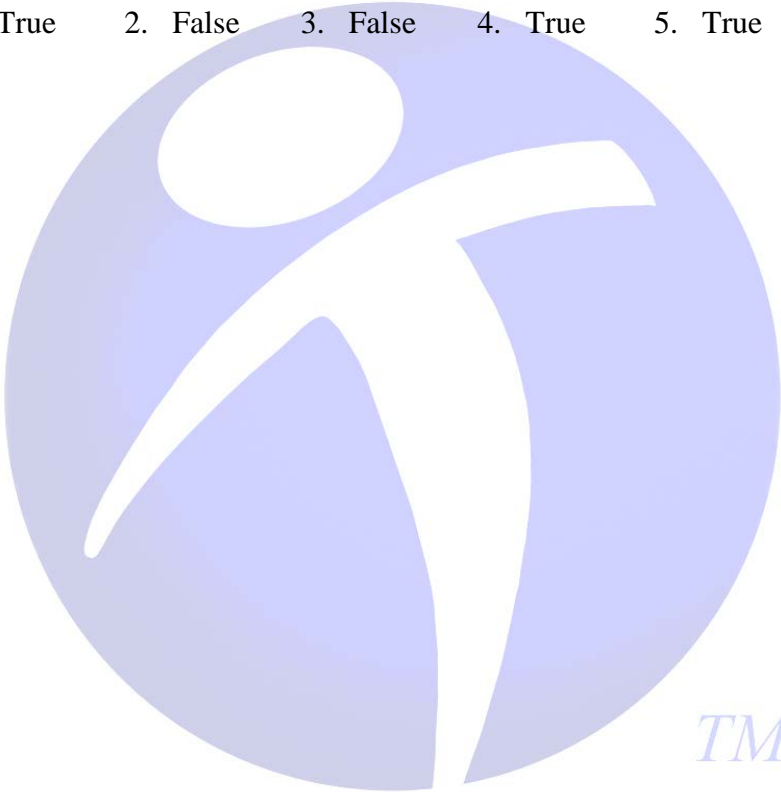
