3 Ways to **FOCUS** your Prayerwalking



As you prayerwalk, focus on the following three areas of prayer:

- 1 Pray according to what you **KNOW** about the people, community, and area you are praying for.
- 2 Pray according to what you **OBSERVE** or **SEE** as you are in the community or area.
- 3 Pray according to the **INSPIRATION** of God's Spirit. He will prompt you and give you spiritual insight as to how you need to pray as you pray scripture and are sensitive to His leadership.

Pray for believers to be renewed in the joy of God's salvation. ~ Psalm 51:10–13

Pray for believers to live with Christ-like character before the world. ~ John 17:11

Pray for divine protection from Satan. ~ John 17:15

Pray believers will lead set apart and holy lives in Christ. ~ John 17:17

Pray for Christians to be united in mission and purpose. ~ John 17:20–21
