First Baptist Church will pay 25% of the camp pre-registration for students who are regular attenders of First Baptist Church. To be eligible, camp registration must be filled out and turned into the church by the appropriate deadline.

The Christian Education Committee contact is responsible for arranging transportation to and from Crystal Springs Camp for attenders of the student camps. Volunteer drivers for the church bus/van and/or parents taking kids to camp are the usual methods. Coordination should be made with the church office.
