Ever Heard of John Spurgeon?

"The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing." Psalm 23:1

"We have all things and abound; not because I have a good store of money in the bank, not because I have skill and wit with which to win my bread, but because the Lord is my Shepherd."

– Charles Haddon Spurgeon (1834-1892)

Many of us are familiar with the 19th century British preacher, Charles Haddon Spurgeon. In 1931, a woman chose to give Spurgeon's middle name to her soon-to-be-born son. She gave him the first name of *Haddon*. Interestingly, Haddon W. Robinson's life would emulate Spurgeon's in several ways. In 1996, Haddon Robinson made the Baylor University list of one of the twelve most effective preachers in the English-speaking world, joining the ranks of Billy Graham and John Stott and others. Two different men named "Haddon" became well known.

Now you know about Charles Spurgeon and you know something about Haddon W. Robinson. Yet, do you know anything about *John Spurgeon*? Ever heard of him? He was the father of Charles. He was himself a pastor and the son of a pastor. Yet, if his son had not achieved such fame as a preacher, John Spurgeon would have served the Lord faithfully, gone to his grave, and we never would have heard of him.

Countless believers like John Spurgeon have walked with God, served Christ throughout the living of their days, and gone to their reward without any notice in the sight of the world. May each of us be content following a similar journey through this life. Our calling is to remain faithful to our faith, strong in our commitments to one another.

Remember, the Lord never said, "Well done, good and famous servant." He does say, "Well done, good and faithful servant." If God makes you as famous as Charles Spurgeon, that's His business. Your business is to be as faithful as John Spurgeon.
