MOVE GROUP GUIDE WEEK 2

Key Scriptures

All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance, admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth. Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- In this week's message Eric said, "Our understanding of eternity, should greatly impact the decisions that we make today." What are some specific ways this may impact your decisions?
- What do you see as the biggest barriers to living life from an eternal perspective?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

 Take time as a group to pray for God to give you an even better understanding of His promises. Pray for boldness and strength in making decisions from an eternal perspective.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
