TODAY'S READING: JOHN 2:1-12
JOURNAL BY MURIEL BLACK

SCRIPTURE: IS THERE A VERSE(S) THAT STOOD OUT TO ME?

John 2:5 - But his mother told the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

OBSERVATION: WHAT IS GOD SAYING TO ME?

Sometimes I don't listen to what God is trying to tell me. I doubt, I hesitate, I make excuses. But if I listen to God and obey Him, His glory will be revealed, just as Jesus' glory was revealed by the miracle of turning water into wine. Even such a seemingly "small" miracle was able to reveal Jesus' glory, and yet it signified something so much bigger - that in our brokenness, we can be made into a new creation through Jesus.

APPLICATION: WHAT AM I GOING TO DO ABOUT IT?

I'm going to take more time to listen to God. After I pray, after I read God's Word, I need to really be listening for what God wants me to hear. And when He lays something or someone on my heart, I'm going to follow through. I'm going to do what He asks of me, even when I don't fully understand.

PRAYER: HOW CAN GOD HELP ME LIVE THIS OUT?

God, I want to hear you. I love hearing from you! Help me to be listening because I want you to use me. I'm willing! Give me the confidence to go where you call me and to trust in your plan, no matter how small or big it may seem. Let your glory shine through all that I do. Amen.
