In the fifteenth year of the reign of Emperor Tiberius, when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, and Herod was ruler of Galilee, and his brother Philip ruler of the region of Ituraea and Trachonitis, and Lysanias ruler of Abilene, during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas... (Luke 3:1-2a)

Another year has past. Every year, whether you feel years are going by quickly or slowly, we reflect on the events of the past year. Much as is the case in the scriptural story, we mark the passage of time in our lives by the events that have taken place or the situations in which we find ourselves. In the year that has past, what are the things that you would use to mark



the passage of time? What are things that have happened to you during this year that are memories of significance for 2021?

Perhaps you or a loved one got married. Maybe there was new grandchild. You may have moved to a new house. Maybe a spouse, child, or close friend died. Or maybe the social and political unrest has made an impact on you. Or maybe the ongoing effects of the pandemic have taken their toll. Whatever they are, there are certainly things that have defined this past year for you, good or bad.

The scripture passage above introduces the ministry of John the Baptist and all that he does to prepare the way for the coming of Jesus. John is introducing the most significant thing that will ever happen in the world. He is introducing the thing that will change everything about the world and the relationship between the people of the world and God. And that significant thing happened in the midst of all of the other things that were happening in the world.

As we near the end of 2021 (and every year, actually), we have the opportunity to once again hear the story of this One of significance who comes into our lives to change everything. As we celebrate Christmas together this year, I want you to think about the events of your life from the year. How have these events defined your year? How have they left you feeling?

Wherever you are at with these situations, know that God comes close to you in the birth of Jesus. God comes to you in the place where you are to bring peace, hope and love. God comes to you, to change everything about you and the life that you live. This is the gift of Christmas and the event that marks the passage of time in our lives and the life of the world.

May you be blessed in this Advent/Christmas season.
