#1 Can you think of any examples that demonstrate the first 2 options Pastor John described? Who are they and what happened?

#2 Read Psalm 51:1-6. How does David understand his human condition? Read 51:7-12. What path is David seeking to be exonerated from his sin? Read 51:12-15. What is David's response?

How does this three-fold progression parallel our experience as a Christian?

#3 In your own words, how does the combination of truth and grace solve the problem of sin? What is the problem if you only have one or the other? Do you see any similarities here to the first 2 options?

#4 Think of some examples of people from the Bible who were flawed, yet used greatly by God. Can you think of any from world / American history? In light of the message, what do you have to say about them? What about God?

#5 In what ways has your life been transformed by encountering Christ in truth and grace?

#6 What counsel does the Bible give us about dealing with other Christians who fall into sin? What about ourselves? (See Galatians 6:1) What in this verse did you need to hear?
