


Spiritual Reflections for our Walk of Faith



1 THE LORD IS MY LIGHT AND MY SALVATION—WHOM SHALL I FEAR? THE LORD IS THE STRONGHOLD OF MY LIFE—OF WHOM SHALL I BE AFRAID? 2 WHEN THE WICKED ADVANCE AGAINST ME TO DEVOUR ME, IT IS MY ENEMIES AND MY FOES WHO WILL STUMBLE AND FALL. 3 THOUGH AN ARMY BESIEGE ME, MY HEART WILL NOT FEAR; THOUGH WAR BREAK OUT AGAINST ME, EVEN THEN | WILL BE CONFIDENT.

Psalm 27

4 ONE THING I ASK FROM THE LORD, THIS ONLY DO I SEEK: THAT I MAY DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE, TO GAZE ON THE BEAUTY OF THE LORD AND TO SEEK HIM IN HIS TEMPLE. 5 FOR IN THE DAY OF TROUBLE HE WILL KEEP ME SAFE IN HIS DWELLING; HE WILL HIDE ME IN THE SHELTER OF HIS SACRED TENT AND SET ME HIGH UPON A ROCK.

6 THEN MY HEAD WILL BE EXALTED ABOVE THE ENEMIES WHO SURROUND ME; AT HIS SACRED TENT I WILL SACRIFICE WITH SHOUTS OF JOY; I WILL SING AND MAKE MUSIC TO THE LORD.





PRINCIPLE #1

TELL YOUR FEAR ABOUT YOUR GOD.

The Lord is my light and my salvation — whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life — of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalm 27:1

"THE LORD IS MY ROCK, MY FORTRESS AND MY DELIVERER; 3 MY GOD IS MY ROCK, IN WHOM I TAKE REFUGE, MY SHIELD AND THE HORN OF MY SALVATION. HE IS MY STRONGHOLD, MY REFUGE AND MY SAVIOR—FROM VIOLENT PEOPLE YOU SAVE ME. 4 "I CALLED TO THE LORD, WHO IS WORTHY OF PRAISE, AND HAVE BEEN SAVED FROM MY ENEMIES...

29 YOU, LORD, ARE MY LAMP; THE LORD TURNS MY DARKNESS INTO LIGHT.



PRINCIPLE #1

TELL YOUR FEAR ABOUT YOUR GOD.

PRINCIPLE #2

PRIORITIZE GOD'S PRESENCE OVER HIS PROVISION.

Psalm 27:4




PRINCIPLE #2

PRIORITIZE GOD'S PRESENCE OVER HIS PROVISION.


Desiring to be with God before wanting to receive anything from God.



Jeremiah 33:3




PRINCIPLE #4

Waiting is not wasting:


Look for the things that God is doing instead of focusing on what He hasn't done yet.

THEY WHO WAIT FOR THE LORD SHALL RENEW THEIR STRENGTH;


THEY SHALL MOUNT UP WITH WINGS LIKE EAGLES; THEY SHALL


RUN AND NOT BE WEARY; THEY SHALL WALK AND NOT FAINT.
