Blessed is she who has believed that the Lord would fulfill his promises to her!"









# Eulogia = "blessing word"

Literally, "praise-word" in response to the presence and work of God.






















- 2) Discipleship—carry Jesus wherever you go.

  - Unlike Mary, Jesus does not leave our bodies.


Repeat the sounding joy – how do we sing this song? Discipleship – carry Jesus wherever you go. Be careful about exalting Mary over Jesus.




