We also have a young guy named Paul who faithfully comes to church. His parents are not saved yet, but they let him come to the services. I try to disciple him a bit and help him grow in the Lord. Please pray that his parents would get saved and he would keep coming.

Two other young men named Nico and Arsenio are also faithful church members. Nico is about 27 years old and would love to get married. This is a real struggle for him to have patience and wait for the Lord's timing. He loves to come to the church, but keeps struggling to fight against worldly things although he is a very faithful witness for the Lord. He has a friend named Jackie who he tries to reach with the gospel. Arsenio is one of the guys who is very close to me and wants to learn more than just the average person. He is a semi-professional soccer player and witnesses to all his friends, especially Raven, Steven, Prince and Koray. He is not ashamed to talk about the Lord.
