 - o In his asking Jesus, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?"
 - o In his hearing Jesus' answer, "You know the commandments..."
 - o In his telling Jesus, "All these I have kept..."
 - o In his hearing Jesus tell him to, "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."
 - o In his response, "He went away sad."
- In what ways do you see yourself in the character of Jesus' disciples?
 - In their hearing Jesus say, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God."
 - o In their asking Jesus, "Who then can be saved?"
 - o In their hearing Jesus' answer, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God."

- How have you experienced the truth of "The Point—In Context:"
