Calling on the Name of the Lord: Experiencing God's Promises through Prayer Lord, Teach Us to Pray, Part 1, Luke 11:1, 5-13

- In Luke 11:1, Jesus' disciples make a request of him. "Lord, teach us to pray."
 - Make that request of Jesus, personally, right now.
 - **"Lord, teach *me* to pray."**
 - Listen to Him. Learn from Him.
 - Consider *how* he prayed—Luke 11:2-4; Matthew 6:9-13.
 - Consider *what he taught* about praying—Luke 11:5-13.

- Based on Jesus' teaching on prayer in Luke 11:5-13, Sunday's sermon emphasized three points:
 - Pray with Persistence—Ask of God;
 - Pray with Assurance—Receive from God;
 - Pray with Expectance—Trust in God.

- In prayerful reflection, **ask God**—Father, Son, and Spirit—**to teach you how to:**
 - Pray with Persistence—Ask of God;
 - Pray with Assurance—Receive from God;
 - Pray with Expectance—Trust in God.
