Meanwhile: Waiting for God's Promises
2 Peter 1:12—2:22

The Point of the sermon was: Trust God and His Word. That is as much a “heart” issue as a “head” issue—something to be “felt” as much as something to be “believed.”

- Read and reflect on Psalm 19.
- Take time to contemplate the descriptive terms the Psalmist uses to depict God's Word.
- Experience the Psalmist's “feeling” of trust in God and His Word, as well as the affirmation of his “belief.”

Peter encourages us to Trust God and His Word, specifically the promise, “the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials” (2 Peter 2:9).

- How has the Lord rescued you from trials?
 - Recount the experience as a testimony to this promise of God.
- What trial are you facing today?
 - Pray with confidence this promise of God's.

In both of these ways, reaffirm that you, truly, Trust God and His Word.
